

## 集結商界力量推動全人發展

### Enterprises Empower Whole-Person Development

商界與學術界,看似是截然不同的領域,可是當兩者跨界交融,卻能擦出不一樣的火花,培育未來社會翹楚。崇基校董伍燕儀女士,亦為崇基校友,一九九〇年畢業於香港中文大學(中大)工商管理學系,自此投身商界逾三十載,現今為花旗集團全球財富管理亞太區主管,在銀行領域累積豐富經驗。作為商界成功人士、崇基校董,並兼任崇基財務委員會成員及崇基學院獎學金及獎項專責小組召集人,伍女士如何將商界經驗,融入於推動崇基學生的全人發展?見證今昔學院面貌變遷,她有甚麼體會和期望?

#### 地靈人傑在崇基

早於初中年代,伍女士已嚮往崇基學院的校園生活 「猶記得中一暑假時參加了一個夏令營,活動地點 正正是崇基學院,當時覺得學院的環境相當優美, 及後到中三暑假時,再次到崇基學院參與夏令營 人神往,加上我本身為基督徒,促使我決定考入中 大,並加入擁有基督教背景的崇基學院。」 伍女士 開懷地娓娓道來,「除了主修科目外,學院讓我們 自由旁聽喜愛的學科,我當時揀選了哲學和心理學 在通識教育方面獲益良多。」回想昔日甚是嚮往的 崇基校園,她認為以「地靈人傑」來形容便最為貼 切——「地靈」,在於其環境清幽雅致;「人傑」, 並非在於傑出人才,而在於學院推行博雅教育,培 育學生多角度思考,激勵他們持續跨領域學術追求。 伍女士藉此鼓勵崇基同學積極旁聽其他學科,除了 增進跨領域的常識,亦可鍛鍊水平思考,在解決問 題時更懂得靈活變通。

The business and academic sectors appear to be entirely different in nature. However, the integration of both can spark chemistry beyond imagination and nurture elites for the future. Ms. Ng Yin Yee Angel, Chung Chi College Trustee and alumna, graduated with the degree of Bachelor of Business Administration from The Chinese University of Hong Kong (CUHK) in 1990 and has engaged in the commercial sector for over three decades. Currently the Head of Asia Pacific Global Wealth Management, Citi, Ms. Ng has gained substantial experience in the banking industry. As a successful senior executive, a College Trustee, a member of Chung Chi's Finance Committee, as well as the Convener of the Task Force on Revamping of CCC Scholarships and Awards Regime, how does Ms. Ng put her profound expertise to good use and integrate it into the wholeperson development of Chung Chi students? Having witnessed the transformation of the College over the years, what is she looking forward to regarding College development?

#### **Chung Chi: Enlightening Cradle of Eminent People**

As early as Ms. Ng received junior secondary education, she had a craving for campus life at Chung Chi College. "When I was a form one student, I joined a summer camp at the College. I was impressed by the supreme beauty of Chung Chi. Two years later, as a form three student, I joined another summer camp at the same place again. The vibrant greeneries and picturesque landscape of the lakeshore ignited my determination to spend my university life there. Also, as a Christian, it's a natural tendency for me to want to join Chung Chi, the only College with a Christian background," Ms. Ng said cheerfully, "apart from majors, the

#### 回歸母校 回饋母校

College also encouraged us to sit in on the classes of the subjects that we favoured. I was interested in psychology and philosophy. Sitting in on such classes had broadened my exposure to general education." Recalling her sweet memory in the much-cherished College, she thought it could be best described as an "Enlightening Cradle of Eminent People". "Enlightening Cradle" refers to the serene and graceful environment, and "Eminent People" not to outstanding talent, but humans pursuing crossdisciplinary knowledge throughout their lifetime. It is the College's liberal education that inspires students to perceive anything from multiple perspectives. Ms. Ng encourages Chung Chi students to expose themselves to a broad array of subjects, which not only enhances their understanding of a wide range of disciplines, but also fosters their lateral thinking. As a result, they can solve problems more resourcefully.

#### **Coming Home and Giving Back**

Today, Ms. Ng is a senior executive in the banking industry. Why is she eager to be a Chung Chi Trustee and take care of College affairs amid her hectic schedules? "When I come home, I mean giving back. It is Chung Chi that has nourished me with great care. Supporting my alma mater is what I am meant to do. Relatively, the College has invested its greatest resources to nurture talent, namely Chung Chi alumni, across generations. When taking a role in College development, I can strengthen the bond with Chung Chi and other alumni. On the other hand, I can make use of this valuable opportunity to meet young people to get to know what they think and be inspired from a brand new perspective." That's why she believes that coming home is not purely giving back to her alma mater, but also learning a lot from taking part in College affairs.

#### Nurturing Talent with Crossover Collaboration

Being well experienced in the business world, Ms. Ng had already thought of incorporating her expertise into College development for fostering holistic education when she returned to Chung Chi. She said the management models of private enterprises and the College are entirely different. The governance system of the commercial sector has been evolving to keep abreast with the rapid changes in social and economic development. Chung Chi has to be in line with the future so as to nurture talent for meeting the changing needs of society. As the Convener of the Task Force on Revamping of CCC Scholarships and Awards Regime, Ms. Ng has curated a scholarship scheme by leveraging her network and experience in the business arena. #### 見證今昔學院面貌 新舊交融

由大學時代到今日回歸母校擔任校董要職,伍女士 見證了學院三十載的變遷。回想昔日校園滿目大自 然景致,荷花池(現稱「未圓湖」)綠草如 茵,對 比今日校園設有更多大型建築物,不少草地舖砌了 石磚或改建為行人路,她既欣賞漸趨現代化的校園, 硬件配套為學生帶來便利,亦迎合現今大學發展所 需;同時亦有感昔日傳統學院的歷史面貌值得悉 保存。她深繫學院的一草一木、一磚一瓦,希望學院新舊交融,兩者可相輔相成,「崇基的歷史痕跡, 亦是學院傳統人文精神的象徵,未來世世代代崇基 人在這個充滿人文素養的育才園地學習,嶄新設施 無疑迎合發展所需,而舊日的自然景觀也希望得以 完好保留。」

#### 宿舍生活:大學生涯重要滋養

除了推行獎學金外,伍女士認為宿舍生活是全人教育不可或缺的元素。她在大學時期因未能成為宿生而略有遺憾:「當時我在大圍居住,較為鄰近中大校舍,加上大學仍未推行四年一宿的計劃,故此我沒有機會入住宿舍。可是,我當時非常渴望體驗宿舍生活,於是長年於多個崇基宿舍『屈蛇』(偷偷地去宿舍留宿)。」伍女士笑説,無論在明華堂、文質堂及何善衡夫人宿舍也曾有過她留宿的身影。現今中大學生都有機會入住宿舍,想體驗舍堂生活已無須「屈蛇」。她認為,只有入住宿舍,才能令

scholarship is driven by the College's mission of fostering whole-person development through nurturing students "to become virtuous and talented 'master of pen and sword' with a strong mind and spirit," as envisioned by Dr. Chan Tak Lam Norman, Chairperson of the Board of College Trustees. Therefore, the judging criteria of this scholarship not only cover academic performance, but also multiple aspects. Qualified candidates must be active participants of non-academic activities, such as community work, spiritual nourishment, and religious and cultural events, among others.

#### **Harmonious Blend of Old and New**

From being a university student to a College Trustee, Ms. Ng has witnessed the transformation of Chung Chi over three decades. There is a stark contrast between abundant greeneries surrounding the Lotus Pond (now known as "Lake Ad Excellentiam") and natural landscapes in the old days and the modernised campus with grand buildings and newly-paved pathways today. She appreciates the advanced infrastructure for enhancing students' convenience and addressing the developmental needs of the University on the one hand, and believes in the importance of preserving the College's historical features on the other. Being deeply into the natural environment and classical edifices, she hopes both old and new elements can be blended seamlessly, "Chung Chi's historical features epitomise the College's traditional spirits. Chung Chi-ers of the next generations will be nourished spiritually in this fertile cradle, which entails the support of both advanced infrastructure and historical landscapes."


#### **Hall Life: Essence of University Journey**

Apart from scholarship, Ms. Ng believes hall life is an essential ingredient of whole-person education. She felt somewhat regret for not being able to be a hall resident, "As I lived in Tai Wai, which is in proximity to the University campus, and CUHK had not yet launched the 'Guaranteed Residence Scheme', I wasn't granted permission to live in a student hostel. Nevertheless, my passion for hall life didn't fade away. I kept staying in different Chung Chi hostels like Ming Hua Tang, Wen Chih Tang, and Madam S. H. Ho Hall in secret without registration," she said gleefully. Now. CUHK students have opportunities to live in a hall and need not stay in a hostel secretly. She said students can only enjoy university life by living in a hostel, during which they can have all-round development with the improvement of communication and problem-solving skills. In light of this, she hopes Chung Chi can build more hostels and other infrastructures, such as Project E, which is

#### 提升軟技能 迎合智能社會需求

現今,人工智能日漸發達的社會,有不少工種逐漸 被淘汰,伍女士寄語崇基畢業生投身社會,必須提 升軟技能。她表示,科技不斷進步,令不少實務性 質的工作升級,例如營運管理在當今世代已經逐漸 被科技取代,但人工智能未能取代需要發揮人類智 慧的工作。她説:「就算再發達的科技,也未能取 代人類獨有的特質,包括軟技能、人與人之間的 任、人性化思維、個人見解等,因此,畢業生必須 增強人文科學的知識,並提升軟技能,例如溝通及 人際關係技巧、分析及問題解決技巧等,並時刻對 新事物保持好奇心,鍛鍊水平思維,以迎合當今社 會需要。」

#### **Sharpening Soft Skills in Smart Society**

Nowadays, we are living in a techno-driven society where artificial intelligence (AI) has become more prevalent. Many jobs have been disappearing. Ms. No. encourages Chung Chi students to sharpen their soft skills when entering the job market. She believes numerous jobs of operational nature have been upgraded, for example, operational management has been replaced with advanced technology gradually. Having said that, Al cannot replace jobs which entail human wisdom. She said, "The even more advanced technology cannot replace the unique quality of human beings, including soft skills, trust, human thinking, and personal views, among others. Therefore, graduates should be equipped with knowledge of humanities, and enhance soft skills like communication and interpersonal skills, and analytical and problem-solving techniques. They should also stay curious and polish their lateral thinking skills for addressing the needs of society today."

#### 何宿首奪傅盃全場總冠軍

Ho Hall Won Its First Ever Fu Cup Overall Championship

崇基人對於傅元國盃(傅盃)並不陌生,傅盃由已故 前崇基院長傅元國教授(1933-2015)於一九七八年 創辦,是崇基傳統體育盛事,參賽者皆為崇基宿生, 目的在於提升同學對宿舍及學院的歸屬感,並促進舍 堂之間的聯繫。因新冠疫情停辦三年的傅盃於今年二 月復辦,而何善衡夫人宿舍(何宿)更破天荒奪得 盃全場總冠軍,於足球、羽毛球、攻城、牌藝及拔河 五項比賽奪冠,成績彪炳。我們邀請何宿足球隊 劉燦裕同學(經濟學/三年級)、應屆何宿宿生會 會前體育幹事貝慧雅同學(能源與環境工程學/五年 級)分享籌備及訓練傅盃的點點滴滴。 Fu Cup is not unfamiliar at all to Chung Chi-ers. Founded by the late former College Head Prof. Fu Yuen Ko Philip (1933-2015) in 1978, Fu Cup is Chung Chi's traditional sports gala with its student residents as participants. Fu Cup aims to enhance students' sense of belonging to their hostels and the College, as well as strengthen the bond among Chung Chi hostels. Having been suspended for three years due to the coronavirus pandemic, Fu Cup was resumed in February this year, and Madam S. H. Ho Hall (Ho Hall) won its first ever Fu Cup Overall Championship. Ho Hall achieved brilliant performance by being the champion of five competitions, namely football; badminton; stone,

#### 問:是甚麼原因驅使你們投入傅盃賽事? 籌備比賽的過程如何?

We invited Mr. Lau Tsan Yu Steve (Economics/3), Captain of Ho Hall Football Team; Ms. Li Pui Ka Bella (Early Childhood Education/1), Chairperson of Ho Hall Residents' Association (RA); and Ms. Pui Wai Nga Cyrus (Energy and Environmental Engineering/5), former Sports Officer of Ho Hall RA, to share with us the anecdotes about their preparation and training for Fu Cup.

#### Q: What motivated you to be dedicated to Fu Cup? How did you prepare for the competitions?

Fu Cup is Chung Chi's significant sports gala that student residents must join. Some seniors always mention that Fu Cup is an ever boisterous and overwhelming sports event. As some of our hallmates love sports, which further motivated us to take part in the post-pandemic Fu Cup to leave us a sweet memory in university life. Concerning the preparation, we organised the Fun Day in October and November last year, enabling hallmates to try various sports like tug-of-war; then we held regular training sessions for teammates to get to know one another and receive training together. In last December and January,

#### 問:訓練及備戰傅盃佔用很多時間 嗎?會否影響課業?

從參賽者的角度來看,影響不算太大。 我們會預先詢問隊友,哪些時段可以進 行訓練,確保大家都有空參與,所以不 會影響上課日程。相對地,籌備傅盃則 需要投入大量時間和精力,剛才提及的 同樂日、定期鍛練及訓練營皆由宿生會 籌備,因為要配合隊長、教練及參賽者 的日程,在編排時間表方面比較困難。 此外,在預訂體育場館作為訓練用途,也 耗費不少時間和體力。因為康文署的體 育場館有不少人爭相使用,我們需要即 時查看已預訂的場館,例如籃球訓練便 需要預訂四個羽毛球場,就算可以網上 預訂,亦難以看到場館的空置情況,因 此,我們通常親身到體育場館排隊預訂。 由於排隊人數眾多,我們不時於清晨甚 至凌晨時段到場館外排隊,有時甚至「通 頂瞓街」。當日完成預訂後會非常勞累, 唯有待充分休息後再追回課業進度。


training camps were held at Cheung Chau for participants to have intensive training in basketball, volleyball, and shuttlecock while regular training kept going on. Each competition was led by a captain and a vice-captain. Some even had a coach who would give advice and instructions to participants.

#### Q: Did you spend a lot of time in training and preparation? Did it affect your studies?

The influence was not too serious from the participants' perspective. We would ask our teammates in advance when they could receive training, ensuring we were all available and our class schedules would not be affected. On the contrary, the preparation took a lot of time and energy. The Fun Day, regular training, and training camps as just mentioned were organised by the Residents' Association. As we had to accommodate the schedules of captains, coaches, and participants, it was rather difficult to arrange the timetable for these training programmes. What's more, making reservations of sports venues for training was another time- and energyconsuming task. Since the sports venues of the Leisure and Cultural Services Department (LCSD) are always fully occupied, even if we could make online reservations, we had to check instantly what venues had been booked. For example, four badminton courts had to be reserved for basketball training, but we could hardly check online whether desirable venues were available in one go. Therefore, we would rather

make reservations in person. Due to long queues, we always lined up outside the venues in the early morning or even at midnight, and slept outdoors overnight occasionally. We were extremely exhausted afterwards and could only catch up with our studies after taking a good rest.

#### Q: What made Ho Hall outstanding in Fu Cup?

Many of the hallmates are good at sports, for example, our football players belong to the University football team, and badminton players are also members of the Hong Kong Badminton Association. What's more, we are so thankful for our warden Dr. Li Chun Hong, former residents as well as hostel staff who were willing to guide our participants and give them some tips on the competitions. Fu Cup offers a jackpot scheme in which each hostel can choose a competition as its trump, and its score will be doubled. For example, we chose basketball (boys) as our trump and ended up having our scores doubled from 50 to 100. That's why making smart choices is also a winning factor. Of course, the unity and commitment of our hallmates are of utmost importance. Most of them were willing to take part in all the regular training programmes even though they did not join all competitions. We were utterly impressed. Although the post-pandemic Fu Cup appeared to be less overwhelming compared to the pre-pandemic competitions, we still hope more Ho Hall's hallmates can actively join this Chung Chi's traditional sports gala, which will definitely enhance their sense of belonging to Ho Hall and the College.

崇基學院成員及崇基學院校董會主席陳德霖博士,獲中大校董會委任為大學校董會副主席,任期兩年,由二〇二三年四月十八日起生效。陳博士曾領導多個大型金融機構,包括出任香港金融管理局總裁、擔任二十國集團設立的國際金融穩定理事會成員,並曾出任該理事會的監管合作常設委員會主席、查打銀行亞洲區副主席、香港特別行政區行政長官辦公室主任,以及二〇二一年八月起出任崇基校董會主席。

Dr. Chan Tak Lam Norman, Chairman of the Board of Trustees of Chung Chi College, has been appointed by the Council of CUHK as its Vice-Chairman for a term of two years with effect from 18 April 2023. Dr. Chan is a distinguished leader in the financial industry. He was the Chief Executive of the Hong Kong Monetary Authority; a member of the Financial Stability Board (FSB) established by the G20 and Chairman of the FSB's Standing Committee on Supervisory and Regulatory Cooperation; Vice Chairman, Asia of Standard Chartered Bank; and Director of the Chief Executive of the HKSAR's Office. #### 下任崇基院長候薦人關美寶教授分享會



#### Sharing Session of Professor Kwan Mei-Po, Candidate for the Next Head of Chung Chi College

崇基學院院長遴選委員會由大學校長段崇智教授擔任主席、崇基校董會主席陳德霖博士,以及六名學院院務委員為成員於數月前成立。經過多輪遴選程序,包括三場諮詢會、提名收集、面見被提名人和開會商議後,遴選委員會通過向崇基校董會及大學校董會推薦崇基校友關美寶教授作為下任崇基學院院長。

關美寶教授(一九八五/崇基地理)是國際知名的地理學家,致力於進行創新和前瞻性的研究,以造福社會,改善民生。畢業於中大的她,於一九八九年和一九九四年分別獲得美國加州大學洛杉磯分校和聖巴巴拉分校的城市規劃碩士學位和地理學博士學位,其後於美國俄亥俄州立大學和伊利諾大學厄巴納一香檳分校等從事教研工作。二〇一九年,關教授回到中大擔任太空與地球信息科學研究所所長和卓敏地理與資源管理學教授,將其豐富經驗回饋母校。關教授在國際地理學界和社會科學界享負盛名,屢獲殊榮,包括二〇一一年美國地理學家協會的傑出學術成就獎、二〇二一年美國地理學家協會的威爾班克斯地理學變革研究獎,以及二〇二二年美國地理學家協會應用地理學專業組的最高榮譽勳章。她同時亦心繫母校,竭力啟發學生,培養人才。


The Committee for the Selection of Head of Chung Chi College was established several months ago, chaired by Professor Rocky Tuan (Vice-Chancellor and President), Dr. Norman Chan (Chairman of the College Board of Trustees), and six College Fellows. After multiple rounds of selection procedures, including three consultation sessions, nomination collection, meetings with potential candidates, and deliberations by the Selection Committee, the Committee has resolved to recommend Professor Kwan Mei-Po, Chung Chi alumna, as the candidate for appointment as the next College Head, for the College Board of Trustees' and University Council's consideration and approval.

Professor Kwan Mei-Po (1985/Chung Chi/Geography) is an internationally acclaimed Geographer with a passion for conducting innovative research that benefits society and enhances people's livelihoods. After earning her Bachelor's degree from CUHK, she pursued her Master's degree in Urban Planning from the University of California, Los Angeles, in 1989, and her Ph.D. in Geography from the University of California, Santa Barbara, in 1994. She then developed her teaching and research career in renowned universities, including The Ohio State University and University of Illinois at Urbana-Champaign. Since 2019, she has been serving as Choh-Ming Li Professor of Geography and Resource Management and Director of the Institute of Space and Earth Information Science at CUHK. Professor Kwan has gained immense respect of the international geography and social science communities, receiving various prestigious honours and awards, including the Distinguished Scholarship Honors from the American Association of Geographers (AAG) in 2011, the AAG Wilbanks Prize for Transformational Research in Geography in 2021, and the James R. Anderson Medal of Honor in Applied Geography from the AAG Applied Geography Specialty Group in 2022. Her dedications to alma mater, inspiring students as well as cultivating talents are equally noteworthy.

To provide an opportunity for College members to learn more about Professor Kwan's vision for Chung Chi College, the Selection Committee has arranged a sharing session of Professor Kwan to meet stakeholders. The session will take place on 2 June (Fri), 2023 from 6:30 pm to 8:00 pm at Activity Room LG4, Kunkle Student Centre.



The historical outlook of Elisabeth Luce Moore Library

#### 崇基圖書館

論到崇基同學最常去的地方,相信少不了圖書館。崇基 圖書館始於一九五一年,當時暫借中環聖約翰座堂圖書 館。後來學院租用聖公會迎賓館一樓作為第二代圖書 館。一九五六年崇基遷入馬料水,由建築師范文照先生 設計的第三代圖書館落成,位處現今的行政樓,是一棟 兩層高的建築物。不久因應學生增加,學院決定在原馬 料水村興建新館,即現今年路思恰圖書館。



第三代崇基圖書館位處現今的行政樓 The third-generation Chung Chi library was located at the current site of the College Administration Building.

第四代圖書館由建築師周啟謙先生設計,於一九七一年啟用,原設計為地面上兩層,到九十年代再加建一層。圖書館作為崇基師生「智庫」,主要收藏宗教、教學體育、表演藝術、學院通識教育課程書籍及本港教學為特藏、還有校史檔案館儲存崇基歷史資料及文物。二〇一九年,二樓有一部分改為音樂圖書館,收集黑膠唱片、樂譜和音樂書籍,展出哈佛大學下趙如蘭教授(1922-2013)捐贈之多件樂器及視聽資料,並附設音樂室和視聽室供同學練習和使用。據統計,這裡每年使用率高達五十多萬人次,是中大最繁忙的圖書館之一。

#### **Chung Chi Library**

When it comes to the places where Chung Chi students visit most often, the library must be one of them. Established in 1951, the first-generation Chung Chi library was actually the one at St. John's Cathedral in Central, which was borrowed for use on a temporary basis. Later, the College rented the first floor of the Church Guest House as the second-generation library. In 1956, Chung Chi moved to Ma Liu Shui and the third-generation library designed by the architect Mr. Robert Fan was completed. It was a two-storey building located at the current site of the College Administration Building. In response to the increasing number of students, the College soon decided to build a new library (now Elisabeth Luce Moore Library) in the former Ma Liu Shui Village.

The fourth-generation library was designed by the architect Mr. Chau Kai-heem and opened in 1971. The original design was a two-storey building, and an additional floor was built in the 1990s. As the "think tank" for Chung Chi's teachers and students, the library mainly collects books about religion, education, sports, performing arts, the College general education courses, and local teaching materials collection. In addition, Chung Chi College Archive in the library preserves the College's historical materials and relics. In 2019, part of the second floor was renovated as the music library for collecting gramophone records, sheet music and music books, musical instruments as well as audio-visual materials donated by Prof. Rulan Chao Pian (1922-2013) from Harvard University. There are music rooms and audio-visual rooms for students' practice and use. According to the statistics, the Chung Chi library is one of the busiest libraries in CUHK with an annual usage rate of more than 500,000.
