Chung Chi College, The Chinese University of Hong Kong FLY Award - Find a Learning Opportunity Yourself Application Guidelines

FLY Award (遊歷學習計劃) aims to enrich Chung Chi students' international exposure and motivate students to explore their potential through learning abroad. The Award provides financial support for students to further their personal development with an international perspective, participate in **short-term non-local programmes or activities** organized by recognized institutes, academies or organizations.

Activities Abroad and Learning Outcomes

Students are encouraged to actively explore different learning opportunities overseas, including but not limited to:

- 1. Professional Training / Interest Course
- 2. Volunteer Service
- 3. Competition / Performance
- 4. Conference / Symposium
- 5. Internship/Field Trip
- 6. Short-Term Academic Course

which are able to achieve at least one of the following learning outcomes:

- ♦ To gain professional development of knowledge or skills; develop positive attitudes and values;
- ♦ To develop a sense of social responsibility and civic engagement;
- ♦ To recognize cultural diversity and demonstrate the ability to take another's perspective;
- ♦ To apply the knowledge or experience earned to local or global contexts.

The College reserves the right to decide if the activities are eligible for such Award.

Eligibility

Each student will be granted the Award up to **two times** within the normative study period for activities in two different natures. Due to the limited quota, the activities without other financial support will have priority.

*Remarks

The College provides EYE (Excel Yourself through Exploration) Award for programmes organized/subsidized by the College, and FLY (Find a Learning Opportunity Yourself) Award for outreaching activities organized by recognized parties. Every Chung Chi student is eligible to apply for these 2 awards with one of the following possibilities:

- 1. Two (2) EYE Awards
- 2. One (1) EYE Award + One (1) FLY Award
- 3. Two (2) FLY Awards

The College reserves the right to decide if the activities are eligible for such Award.

Subsidy

Successful applicants will receive each time an award up to HK\$10,000 or 50% of their actual expenses, whichever the lower. The Award covers the following items:

- Programme fee to be paid to organizer
- Accommodation
- Airfare
- Visa
- Insurance

*Remarks

The Award only covers the activity period and a buffer period of 1-2 days before and after the activity. Otherwise, the award amount may be adjusted.

The College reserves the right of the decision on the Award amount.

Students should fill out the Webform [click here]. All applications should apply before the commencement of the activity. An interview may be arranged for further assessment.
