Notes for Application for Summer Student Hostel 2024

- 1. Only applications from current students of Chung Chi College will be accepted.
- 2. Hostel opened for summer student residence in 2024 (to be confirmed): Pentecostal Mission Hall Complex Low Block (Period AB), Hua Lien Tang and Ying Lin Tang
- 3. Online Application period: April 19, 2024 to 23:59 of April 30, 2024 (Tuesday)
- 4. Residence period and fees

Period A: May 24 to July 3, 2024 \$3440 each Period B: July 3 to 31, 2024 \$2408 each Period C: July 31 to August 12, 2024 \$1032each Period D: August 12 to 25 2024 \$1885 each Period E: August 25 to 30, 2024 \$1575 each

- Late applicants are required to pay HK\$500. Applications after May 15 will NOT be considered.
- Successful applicants are required to pay HK\$600 as summer hostel deposit.
- Applicants who apply for change of residence period after May 15 are required to pay HK\$500 per request.
- 5. Only the above residence periods are available for application. Period C and beyond will only be assigned to non-final year students. Period D will only be assigned to helper of College Orientation Camp normally. To provide enough time for hostel attendants to clean the room before the regular residents move in, Period E will only be approved for necessary cases. Applicants who have special needs shall provide supporting document together with the application form for the Committee to consider.
- 6. Successful applicants are required to pay the full fee for the approved residence period. Summer hostel fee will **NOT** be counted in pro-rata basis. Students who check-in late or check-out early are also required to pay the full fee for the approved residence period. Applicants who would like to change the residence period should inform the Committee by email before May 15 so that amendment could be made in time.
- 7. The information provided will be checked. The application will be revoked if any false information, inaccurate information or forge document is found. Such cases will be forwarded to related units for following up on disciplinary action.
- 8. Applicants who would like to withdraw the application should inform the Committee via their CUHK webmail account as soon as possible, the result will be announced in early-May and a fee of HK\$500 will be charged if the withdrawal is received after the result is announced.
- 9. The result will be announced in early-May. Unsuccessful applicants or applicants not assigned their applied period could apply for special selection within one week after the result is announced.
- 10. Applicants should check at the CUSIS system for the hostel payment in late May and the payment should be settled by June 15. The University will charge all late payment a penalty of \$200.
- 11. The hostel place assigned is not transferable. Hostel places made available later will be assigned to those in the waiting list accordingly.
- 12. The hostel and room assignment will be made by the Committee according to the period of stay approved.
- 13. Residents of period C, D and E may be required to move to another room during the stay for hostel attendants to clean up rooms.
- 14. Residents must move out of the hostel before 12:00 noon of the last day of the approved residence period (Period E: move out before 9:00 am of the last day). If not, cases will be handled according to Hostel Regulations.
- Residents' Association of summer student hostel will be appointed by the warden. 15.
- 16. Chung Chi College Student Hostels Committee reserves the right of assigning the hostel places.
