



NOTICE FROM STUDENT HOSTELS COMMITTEE

Residence Arrangement for Non-local students

Starting with 2016/2017 admission, non-local students will be guaranteed three years of hostel place during their undergraduate studies at CUHK if they wish to stay on campus. Non-local students are also encouraged to take up off-campus accommodation for one academic year during their studies to enrich their exposures and broaden their perspectives. Chung Chi College reserves some hostel places for the year four and above non-local students to apply. Details are:

1. **Eligibility:** only year 3 and above non-local students can apply.
2. **Timeline:** normally application will be open in October, and the result will be announced in December or January next year, so that those who failed to get a hostel place will have enough time to prepare for their accommodation for the next academic year. Please refer to the notice for the actual schedule each year.
3. **Quota:** half of the number of non-local graduating students in the next academic year; among them 80% will be allocated via the Hostel Point System and 20% will be allocated through the Personal Reason Special Selection.
4. **Assessment:** categories A to D will be concluded every academic year and divided by the number of study year.
