General Requirements

- Expected graduation date after 2025/26 academic year
- CGPA of 2.50 or higher
- Good disciplinary standing
- Cumulative exchange period: Less than one (1) academic year

- Eligible to change ranking later (if applicable)

Documents required

- One of the following:
 - **First-year students:** Public examination result(s) related to your admission to CUHK
 - **Senior-year entry students:** FULL transcript of Higher Diploma or Associate Degree
 - **Other students:** Latest CUHK academic report - unofficial transcript downloaded from CUSIS (after 1 Oct 2025)
- A single file including (a) a statement of all extra-curricular activities AND (b) an essay in English with NO MORE THAN 400 words (with word counts at the end)
- Proof of language proficiency (if required)

Session Four: Submission of Documents and Declaration

Please provide all documents as specified below.

A. ONE of the following:

- (a) First-year students: Photocopy of public examination results, e.g. HKDSE, GCE, IBDP, IAL, SAT, TOEFL, IELTS, Gaokao
- (b) Senior-year entry students: FULL transcript and other document(s) relevant to your admissions to CUHK
- (c) Other students: FULL unofficial transcripts downloaded from CUSIS after 1 October 2025

B. A single file with at most two (2) A4-size pages including the following:

- (a) a statement of all extra-curricular activities participated; and
- (b) an essay in English of NOT MORE THAN 400 words to describe why you would like to join the exchange programme and how you would benefit from the programme. The applicant's name should be shown on top of each page, and the number of words at the end of your essay.

Certificates could be presented during the interview if preferred.

Select Files

C. (Required by selected programmes only) A single file embedding the certificate(s) of language proficiency, e.g. Japanese, French, and German etc.

For TOEFL and IELTS, we only accept result in ONE SINGLE ATTEMPT which is issued on or after 1 September 2024. For students who attended the language class(es) in CUHK can have that highlighted in the academic result.

(Submission by 15 January 2026 is accepted.)

Select Files

TOEFL / IELTS

- Required for English proficiency by most universities
- Only the result in ONE SINGLE ATTEMPT issued on or after 1 September 2024 to be considered valid
- Result issued before the date can be uploaded but it is served as reference only

Interview Period:
Late November or
early December

Before the Interview

- Set clear goal(s) and expectation(s)
- Familiarize with the programme(s) interested

After the Interview

- Review of your own interview performance
- Consider your performance when you adjust the ranking
- Choose the programmes that you are interested in
 - NOT NECESSARY to fill up all 10 choices

Mid-Nov 2025	Announcement of shortlisted applicants & interview schedule
Late Nov – Early Dec 2025	Interviews (Reminder: Please inform us in advance if you cannot join the interview. All absentees without prior notification will be recorded.)
Mid-Jan 2026	Submission of (1) Updated priority (2) Academic report up to 2025/26 Term 1 (3) Proof of language proficiency
Around 23 Jan 2026	Announcement of first round offer
Around 26 Jan – 2 Feb 2026	Announcement of subsequent round offer (on rolling basis)

During Your Exchange

Course Load Requirement (per Term)

- Minimum load: equivalent to 9 credits in CUHK
- Passing at least 6 credits equivalent
- OAL – Verification of full-time enrollment

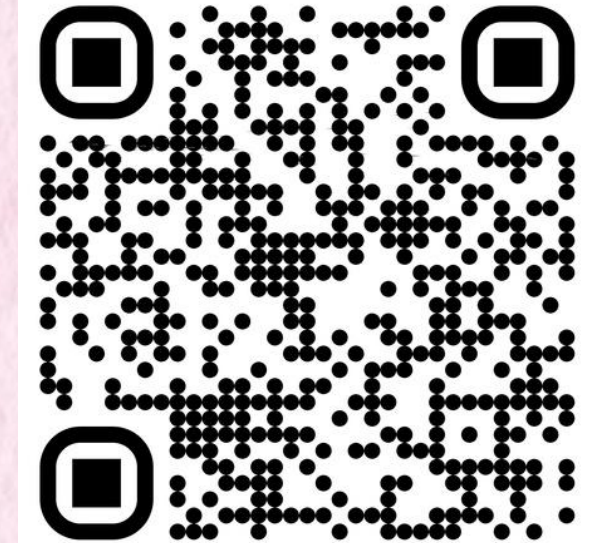
